Fragrant with summer kissed white florals and pink rose, tasty with citrus zest, lychee, peach, rose petal and soft spicy notes on the palate.	14.99

Peachiness is emphasised on the medium-sweet palate where the ripe midpalate is reminiscent of canned peach, cut with a little lemon. This is rounded, mellow and totally full-fruited.	34.99
